**Improving Reading Comprehension by Teaching Alphabetics, Fluency, And Vocabulary* is part of the extended, blended reading PD but is open to everyone during Fall PD Day. Following the face-to-face session participants are invited to participate in a series of five short online courses, at least three live webinars, short readings, and classroom application. This PD connects with *How Teaching Narrative Writing Can Help Students Improve Their Academic Writing* which is an extended, blended writing PD, available mid-year.

**Spring PD Day will be aimed at sustaining and extending the professional development efforts offered during the first part of the year. Information gathered during Fall PD Day and during follow-up webinars will be used to tailor the content of the Spring PD Day with a focus on sharing additional evidence-based strategies and experiences from implementation or peer observations. This will be an opportunity for peer-to-peer interaction and learning how others are addressing and using technology in the classroom, contextualized lessons, career pathways, ESOL instruction, classroom management, and others.
